Subject: Swine Flu

Due to the recent concerns about swine flu currently in the media, Keystone Mercy Health Plan would like to inform our providers about the current CDC recommendations for the management of patients suspected of contracting swine flu.

If swine flu is suspected, providers should obtain a respiratory swab for swine influenza testing and place it in a refrigerator (not a freezer). Once the specimen is collected, the provider should contact their state or local health department to facilitate transport and timely diagnosis at a state public health laboratory. If swine flu is confirmed and medication treatment is required, PerformRx would like to inform providers that per the Keystone Mercy Health Plan formulary, Tamiflu and Relenza are covered without Prior Authorization for one five day treatment course every six months.
